

The Information Governance Delivery Group was tasked by the Chief Medical Officer's Rape and Sexual Assault Taskforce to develop an Information Sharing Agreement and Data Protection Impact Assessment to support the clinical pathways for all people in Scotland who have experienced rape or sexual assault, bring clarity and consistency in information sharing practice and ensure alignment with data protection legislation.

The Information Sharing Agreement and Data Protection Impact Assessment templates outline the legal bases for using personal information, the documents to demonstrate regulatory compliance, and support the clinical pathways for anyone in Scotland who have experienced rape or sexual assault.

As well as the Information Governance Delivery Group, feedback has also been sought from NHS Information Governance Leads and the Clinical Pathways Subgroup of the CMO Taskforce, to ensure that is in line with current practice, guidelines and policies.

As this work has developed there are areas which have key dependencies on other subgroups within the CMO Taskforce and therefore it is important to note that some information is still being developed and work is still ongoing. One related piece of work is the Scottish Government's recent consultation on legislation to improve forensic medical services for victims of sexual offences.
