THE SCOTTISH ROAD WORKS REGISTER (PRESCRIBED FEES) REGULATIONS 2024

The Scottish Road Works Register allows road works authorities and utility companies to meet their statutory obligations in the planning and co-ordination of works on Scottish roads. The New Roads and Street Works Act 1991 enables the Scottish Ministers to provide, by Regulation, that a payment is made to the Scottish Road Works Commissioner for access to the Register.

The Regulation above is being made in exercise of powers conferred by section 112A(4) of the New Roads and Street Works Act 1991 (c.22). Its purpose is to revoke the existing 2022 Regulations, set a new target cost for the overall operation of the Register, and to outline the level of fee payable by road work authorities and undertakers for access to the Scottish Road Works Register. The projected running cost of the Register for 2024/25 is £901,314. No other changes are proposed.

As with the 2019 consultation, we are also seeking your views on the addition of two new awarding bodies for Scotland. At present there are four approved awarding bodies which can issue certificates of competence in road works operations and supervision (the 'streetworks card') via approved assessment centres. We are currently considering approaches from two new providers, Highfield Qualifications and EUIAS, for inclusion on this list. We are keen to seek the views of the road works community specifically on the inclusion of either body within statute.
