It will be used to help make Scottish education better.

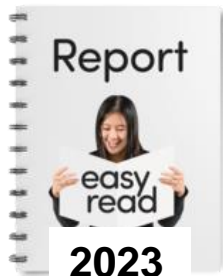

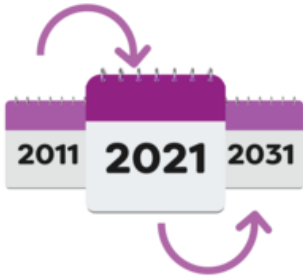

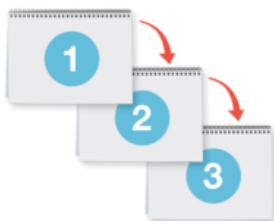
